Edina Barabás graduated as classroom music teacher and choir conductor at the Eötvös Loránd University in 1994.

She worked for the Hungarian Radio Children's Choir between 1994-2014. She taught singing and music at primary level, led the choir of little ones between ages of 8-10 and worked as an assistant conductor of the Hungarian Radio Children's Choir.

Since 2014 she has taught solfege for adults at the Kodály Institute in Kecskemét.

She is a member of the new pilot program of the Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music. In this project she takes part in a music pedagogical research and an innovative - digital music pedagogical software development.

She teaches in Kós Károly Elementary School grades 3rd, 4th, 5th classes and conducts the children's choir of the school.

In the few past years she gave some Kodály courses and solfege lessons not only in Hungary but in Argentina and Russia as well.
